

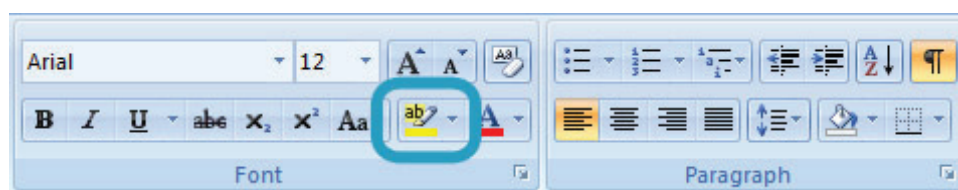
SCHOOLZINE AMENDMENT GUIDELINES

Making amendments to your newsletter content is easy, all you need to do is highlight the changes:

YELLOW: For changed content/grammar and new content, indicate in yellow.

RED: If you want a word or sentence removed, indicate in red.

(The highlighter tool can be found in the font toolbar indicated below.)



If you have a **punctuation** change, make sure to highlight the word next to it.

For **multiple changes** within the one paragraph, make all the changes and **highlight the whole paragraph** in yellow.

A Quick Example

Submitted Content

When indicating the corrected grammar and spelling it is only required to indicate the correct content.

Amended Content

When **you are** indicating **the** corrected grammar and **spelling**, it is only required to indicate the **corrected** content.
