




## OSHC Educator Day

#### **Reading Opens Doors!**

During the month of September 2022, Wilston Kids Care will be teaming up with the Wilston State School Library to hold a 'Great Book Swap' supporting the Indigenous Literacy Foundation to provide all types of books and learning resources to children living in remote communities across Australia.

The Great Book Swap event is a fantastic way to learn more about Indigenous languages and culture, raise funds for a great cause and most importantly, to celebrate reading. This year the 'IDF' is aiming to raise \$350,000 to gift 35,000 new books to remote communities.

How can you help! - We will be accepting donations of books to the service to be used in this great initiative.

Wilston Kids Care has put an invitation out to the Wilston community for any donated or unwanted children's books. The Drop-off Points are WKC office or WSS Library. These books will then be displayed for children to purchase for a gold coin donation. ## Enrolments - Do you need Outside School Hours Care Permantly or Casually?

Do you know we currently have availability in Before and After School Care every day at Wilston Kids Care and have three types of enrolment here at Wilston Kids Care?

Permanent Care Arrangements

Our main form of enrolment is for Permanent Care arrangements. This care arrangement is for children who have a recurring booking each week. This booking is guaranteed to recur until the finalisation of your enrolment.

#### Casual and Occasional Care

Did you know you can book casual and occasional care at Wilston Kids Care?

Whilst we have the permanent care arrangements in place for before and after school care, we also cater for casual/occasional care.

All you need to do is enrol your child by clicking the link below and then book in as you need care. If you haven't attended our service for more than 14 weeks, we will need to reactivate your Child Care Subsidy.

Simply email us once you have book in to alert us your child is coming in casually so we reactive your CCS and make sure we can support them if they have allergies, food intolerance, medical conditions, or inclusion care needs so we can reactive all plans needed and communicate to staff team when they are attending.
